I would also like to thank my stewards, James and Pauline for the excellent job they did in keeping the ring flowing smoothly and, of course, I would like to thank the exhibitors for bringing some quality bitches for me to judge. I found that most of the bitches were in excellent condition but that one or two in the younger classes could have had a little more weight. I found that a lack of ringed tails is still a problem and also still a problem is a fault which I first noticed when I judged quite a few years ago of short ribcage and long loin. Most had lovely, typical Afghan heads.

## MINOR PUPPY BITCH (6)

There were 5 in this class from the same quality litter and it was very difficult to choose between them.

- Parsons' AYOUBKHAN HONEYSUCKLE TO SHUKRIYA—7 months—cream—very promising puppy and, even at this young age, she has personality and presence. Feminine head, good pigmentation, low set ears, correct lay of shoulder and return of upper arm and complementary rear angulation, standing she has a balanced outline, she is in exactly the correct body and coat condition for her age. Moved very well for such a young girl. I think she has a bright future. BPIS
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Stevens' AYOUBKHAN SILVER SAILS another promising puppy, very similar to her litter sister, with a balanced outline and correct front and rear angulation. Didn't move quite as steadily as 1st.

### VETERAN BITCH (9 - 1 abs)

- 1st Fairburn, Roberts & Fillis-Moon's MARINGO EVENING IN PARIS almost 9 years old b/tan beautiful, girl of quality in excellent coat and body condition, lovely head with dark, almond shaped eyes, well balanced outline, with a level topline which she kept on the move, ringed tail she moved with style and elegance.
- $2^{nd}$  Adams' CH ZANDAHAR JUST TIGER LILY JW SH CM -8 years old another beautiful girl in excellent body and coat condition Well placed shoulder, good front and rear angulation. She moved soundly.

#### JUNIOR (5 - 2 abs)

- 1st Collyer-Todd's SHIMALMA KAMORA 15 months brindle, well proportioned head with dark, well shaped eye. Overall balanced conformation, good bone and substance; level topline and correct fallaway. She moved steadily.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Milligan-Bott's MEDAWLARK ATTITUDE IS KEY THE WONES THENDARA (IMP RUS) 16 months b/tan again she has a very feminine head and expression. Good length of ribcage and short loin. I just preferred the front assembly and shoulder placement of 1<sup>st</sup>. Moved well.

## YEARLING (1)

1st Gilbert's ALTSIDE HOT AS HELL AT AFFIETAR – I liked this girl a lot – oyster blue brindle, lovely head and expression, perfectly balanced all through with very good front, correct shoulder placement and return of upper arm, deep chest with spring of rib, good fallaway with correctly set, ringed tail. She was in excellent body condition and her coat was immaculately presented. Exuberant on the move. I think she has a great future.

## MAIDEN (6 - 1 abs)

Beavon's ALTSIDE HOT GOSSIP – litter sister to winner of Yearling – balanced outline with good front and shoulder placement and return of upper arm with complementary rear angulation with good bend of stifle and low hocks. In excellent body and coat condition. She moved soundly covering the ground with long strides

She settled in movement when the handler slowed down.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Hughes' GEZANCOL FALLEN FROM GRACE b/m gold, very nice type, well balanced outline with level topline, correct front and shoulder and correct fallaway ringed tail. I preferred the head of the 1<sup>st</sup>.

## POST GRADUATE (6)

- Hedge's UNSTOPPABLE HAPPY GO LUCKY (IMP SWE) b/t beautiful girl in excellent body and coat condition which was well presented, feminine head with darkest of almond shaped eyes, long strong neck into well placed shoulder, correct return of upper arm, good front assembly. Deep chest with good spring of rib and short strong loin. Good angulation front and rear. On the move, not only does she cover the ground with great front extension but she also has the lift of true Afghan movement which isn't seen so often these days. She also has powerful rear drive. I was delighted to award her first CC and I hope she goes on to greater things
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Bastow's CLOUDSIDE MUINEIRA TO KARANDIKAR black another lovely girl, very well balanced with good front and rear angulation. Deep chest with correct spring of rib. Moved with style, covering the ground with ease. In good muscular condition. Immaculately presented and handled. I was pleased to award her the Res CC.

### MID-LIMIT (5)

- 1st Lancashire & O'Donnell's DRISHAUN CONSIDER THE LILY JW brindle of excellent quality pleasing head with dark eye, long ears, long neck into well placed shoulder, very well balanced outline and good front and rear angulation, presented in excellent condition.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Moore's CLOUDSIDE FLAMENCO brindle with a feminine head, excellent front assembly and shoulder placement, good rear angulation, correct bend of stifle and low hocks. She didn't move as well as 1<sup>st</sup>.

LIMIT (9 - 1 abs)

- 1<sup>st</sup> O'Donnell's FAITH IS LIKE A LILY FOR JAVIDAN JW- red brindle well proportioned head with underjaw, correct placement and angle of shoulder and return of upper arm. Deep chest and ample spring of rib, short strong loin. Beautifully presented. Moved with powerful strides, covering the ground.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Newton's SHIMALMA MIDNIGHT LIAISON brindle, feminine head, long ears, long neck onto well laid shoulder, good rear angulation with low hocks Moved soundly but didn't have the scope of movement of 1<sup>st.</sup>
- 3<sup>rd</sup> McCormack's TULAK NEVER BEEN KISSED

OPEN (6-2 abs)

- 1st Lockett-Davies' CH. BONDOR A GOLDEN AGE OVER RHAZMAKH JW SH CM brindle of excellent quality and type with well balanced conformation throughout. Long neck into well placed shoulder. Level topline, correct fallaway. Excellent, well bodied and muscled condition and immaculately presented coat. Moved soundly.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Bastow's CLOUDSIDE FLASHLIGHT AT KARANDIKAR JW lovely head and expression. Very well proportioned body and shapely outline. Presented immaculately in both coat and body condition. She didn't move quite as well as 1<sup>st</sup>.
