MPD (2, 1a)

1. Davies – Rhajikhan Adrastus – Dark brindle baby of nice shape, attractive head and dark eye, balanced angulation and good body. Moved out steadily and controlled, nice baby.

PD (3)

1. Newton – Shimalma Jagermeister – very raw self masked cream with lovely head and eye, rangy outline with good topline and ring tail. Moved freely when settled. BPD and BPIS.
2. Rhajikhan Adrastus
3. Thornton – Absolute Afghan's Djibouti at Karnak

SVD (7 -10 years) (3)

1. Cullen – Syrdarya Toffy Pop at Eweyisska – 9 year old brindle, masculine head and good eye shape, strong neck, good shoulder and upper arm, level topline and ring tail, well angulated rear. Moved out well despite the heat. BVD
2. Coates – Syrdarya Gari Baldi at Bukhara – heavily coated dark brindle brother to winner. More compact in outline than his brother but equally well made throughout. Moved out well.
3. Latimer – Zharook I Had A Dream.

YD (2)

1. James – Syrdarya Darjeeling Chai of Simkhan – Quality self masked red with lovely well chissled head and dark eye, good angulation front and rear with level topline and ring tail. Moved out freely and well when settled.
2. Beanland, Parcell & Thornton – Gezancol Never Say Never at Harlextan – Masculine black masked gold of different type to 1. Well made youngster with attractive head and expression, good shoulder and strong quarters which he used well on the move. In lovely coat and body condition.

MD (2)

1. Thornton – Absolute Afghan's Djibouti at Karnak – Black masked gold puppy in lovely condition, compact in outline, moved steadily.
2. Davies – Calamus Duke of Oxland – Pale gold of completely different type to 1. Taller and rangier all through, moved well.

1. Absolute Afghan's Djibouti at Karnak

GD (3)

1. Mitchell – Zandahar Xplosive Storm – Shaded cream with attractive head, good shoulder and upper arm, level topline and well angulated rear. Moved with reach and drive.
2. French – Trust Queen Budda at Zalmeerah (Rus Imp) – Black masked silver youngster in lovely coat and condition, balanced angulation front and rear, moved steadily.
3. Mullen – El Roalito Keep Smiling

PGD (3)

1. Thompson – Drishaun The Vampire Lily Via Gothika JW – Quality black masked gold with attractive head and dark eye, strong neck, well angulated shoulder and upper arm, level topline held on the move, good depth and strong quarters finished with a ring tail. Moved with reach and drive covering the ground well. Has matured into a lovely hound. CC and BIS
2. Lancashire & O'Donnell – Drishaun Pictures of Lily – Self masked gold litter brother to 1. Taller and houndier in outline, beautiful head and expression. Equally well made to his brother just not matching his sparkle on the move today. Am sure he also has a bright future.
3. McLay – Cloudside Sun King

MLD (3)

1. Lancashire & O'Donnell – Drishaun Star Among Lilies JW – Litter brother to PG winner. Rangy dark brindle of lovely type, attractive head and dark eye, well angulated front and rear, good depth and topline. Moved with reach and drive covering the ground well.
2. French – Sitana Bijali Toofan at Zalmeerah – Black masked gold with beautiful head and expression, good shoulder and upper arm, level topline held on the move, well angulated quarters and ring tail. Moved out well but not with the sparkle of 1 today
3. Reed – Cloudside Sunstrike JW.

LD (5)

1. Bovey – Sitana Barisa Toofan Karianca – Quality black masked gold of lovely type. Beautiful head and expression, long neck leading to well angulated shoulder and upper arm, good depth and topline, strong rear and ring tail. Moved out with reach and drive to win this class but unfortunately lost his sparkle a bit in the challenge.
2. Lancashire & O'Donnell – Drishaun Fair As A Lily JW – Attractive self masked cream, good head and expression. Another lovely sound youngster with good front and rear angulation, in hard condition and moved out well. Unlucky to meet 1 today.
3. Gorman – Affietar Glen Sheil at Zharook

OD (5)

1. James – Sitana Aag Toofan – Quality self masked cream litter brother to Limit winner. Lovely head and expression, well angulated shoulder and upper arm, good depth and level topline, well angulated rear quarters and ring tail. Moves freely with reach and drive covering the ground with easy strides. Res CC
2. Latimer – Ch. Jeremiah De Koulanger at Zharook JW – Quality black masked gold I have done well for as a youngster. Masculine head and good expression, well angulated front and rear, soundly made throughout, stylish on the move covering the ground well. Has matured into a worthy Champion. Very close between these two lovely hounds.
