

## The Southern Afghan Club List of Judges – A2 – 2010

Indicates those persons whom the Club would support to award C.C.s in the Breed, having fulfilled the following criteria

- a) Twelve years experience in the Breed. (Waived in the case of all rounders)
- b) To have judged seventy-five classes at open show level spanning a minimum period of seven years
- c) To have judged both classes separately at an Afghan Breed Club show or a Breed Club sponsored show
- d) To have bred or owned three dogs that have won their way into the KC Stud Book, or alternatively, owned two dogs in the KC Stud Book plus an additional fifty classes of Afghans (This to include a further ten class Breed Club show).
- e) One of the two Club Shows must be balloted
- f) To have stewarded not less than twelve classes of Afghans
- g) To have passed a recognised Breed Club examination
- h) For persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 List and who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and accepted by The Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list
- i) ALLROUNDERS - To have awarded CCs in three hound breeds and to have judged a minimum of 150 classes of Afghans at open show level
