B/gold, taller than winner, but still a nice bitch and well balanced. Nice head, and good shoulders and upperarm. Slightly longer than 1 in loin, nice fall away and good rear angles. Moved well.

Gold bitch, 1st impression on seeing her is her classic outline and not disappointed when you go over her.

Lovely balanced head and eye, long neck going into well laid back shoulder, and an equal return of upperarm. Great depth of chest, level top-line, good spring of rib and short strong loin. Prominent hipbones, excellent rear angles. Great drive and style on the move that won her BOB and RBIS.
